- GNSO work started on Saturday morning and continued through Thursday
- Working sessions included:

 - Joint meeting with the GAC
 - Dinner meeting with the ICANN Board and Staff
 - Joint meeting with the ccNSO
 - Stakeholder Group and Constituency meetings
- A new record was set for GNSO remote participation including a group of about 60 that met together in Reston, Virginia representing multiple stakeholder groups and constituencies.



GNSO Open Council Meeting Highlights

- A charter for the Registry/Registrar Vertical Integration PDP was approved and a kickoff meeting was held.
- The terms for the two GNSO Improvement Steering Committees were extended.
- The election by the Contracted Party House of Bruce Tonkin to a second term on the Board was confirmed by the Council.

Two Key GNSO Projects Nearing Completion

- GNSO endorsement of Affirmation of Commitments 2010 Accountability and Transparency Review Team volunteers
 - Review of applicants is currently underway.
 - Council approval of endorsements is scheduled for early next week.
- Prioritization of GNSO Projects
 - GNSO volunteers and ICANN Staff support are stretched very thin.
 - A proposed prioritization methodology is near completion.
 - The Council expects to do the prioritization exercise in the next month or two.
